CITY OF CROWLEY REGULAR MEETING APRIL 14TH, 2015

The Mayor and Board of Aldermen of the City of Crowley, Louisiana, the governing authority of the City of Crowley, met in a regular session at 6:00 p.m. Tuesday the 14th day of April, 2015 at the regular meeting place of said Mayor and Board of Aldermen, the Council Chambers, 426 North Avenue F, Crowley, Louisiana.

Mayor Greg A. Jones presided with the following Aldermen present: Bryan Borill, J. Elliot Doré, Jeff Doré, Lyle Fogleman Jr., Tim Monceaux, Steven Premeaux, Ezora J. Proctor and Kitty Valdetero. Alderman Vernon Martin was absent.

Alderman Bryan Borill led the Pledge of Allegiance to the flag. Reverend Keith Matthews gave the invocation.

AGENDA AMENDENTS:

Alderman Bryan Borill offered a motion to amend the agenda to include and consider the rehiring of Jacob Premeaux in the police department. Seconded by Alderman Tim Monceaux and duly adopted after a unanimous vote.

Alderwoman Ezora J. Proctor offered a motion to amend the agenda to include and consider the temporary food sales permits. Seconded by Alderman Bryan Borill and duly adopted after a unanimous vote.

PUBLIC HEARING:

Mayor Jones opened the public hearing on proposed ordinance no. 1467, the ordinance was read by title as follows:

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND SECTION 3.1304 OF ARTICLE III OF APPENDIX A – ZONING, OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF CROWLEY TO INCREASE THE MAXIMUM HEIGHT OF FENCES, WALLS AND HEDGES TO EIGHT (8) FEET ON REAR AND SIDE YARDS TO THE FRONT SETBACK LINE AND THREE (3) FEET FROM THE FRONT SETBACK LINE TO THE FRONT LOT LINE AND ALONG THE FRONT YARD LOT LINE; TO PROVIDE FOR THE PROVISIONS HEREOF TO BE SEVERABLE; TO REPEAL ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES INCONSISTENT THERETO OR IN CONFLICT THEREWITH; AND TO PROVIDE FOR ALL OTHER MATTERS RELATIVE OR PERTAINING THERETO.

Mayor Jones asked for proponents to the proposed ordinance no. 1467. A third and final call was made with no one coming forward to speak. The call for opponents of the proposed ordinance no. 1467 was made and there were no comments after the third and final call. The public hearing on ordinance no. 1467 was closed.

WHEREAS, this phased approach is estimated to save significant cost, depending on the need for patching over time.

ORDINANCE:

The following ordinance no. 1467 has been previously introduced at a regular meeting convened on March 10th, 2015, published by title in the official journal of the City, and a public hearing held thereon on April 14th, 2015. It was offered for final adoption by Alderman Bryan Borill, seconded by Alderman Tim Monceaux and duly adopted.

ORDINANCE NO. 1467

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND SECTION 3.1304 OF ARTICLE III OF APPENDIX A – ZONING, OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF CROWLEY TO INCREASE THE MAXIMUM HEIGHT OF FENCES, WALLS AND HEDGES TO EIGHT (8) FEET ON REAR AND SIDE YARDS TO THE FRONT SETBACK LINE AND THREE (3) FEET FROM THE FRONT SETBACK LINE TO THE FRONT LOT LINE AND ALONG THE FRONT YARD LOT LINE; TO PROVIDE FOR THE PROVISIONS HEREOF TO BE SEVERABLE; TO REPEAL ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES INCONSISTENT THERETO OR IN CONFLICT THEREWITH; AND TO PROVIDE FOR ALL OTHER MATTERS RELATIVE OR PERTAINING THERETO.

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 1433 adopted on the 13th day of December, 2011, erroneously amended Section 3.1304 of Article III of Appendix A – Zoning of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Crowley to provide a maximum height of six (6) feet for fences, walls and hedges along the rear or side yards which was originally amended to provide for a permit fee for all fences of \$40.00 plus additional fees for investigation into the case; and

WHEREAS, the provisions of Ordinance No. 1306 adopted on the 9th day of February, 2005, setting the maximum height for fences, walls and hedges of eight (8) feet in height was inadvertently amended because of a clerical or typographical error which included the number "6" rather than the number "8" when in fact there was no intent to change the maximum permitted height of fences, walls and hedges since as the stated purpose of Ordinance No. 1433

was to provide for the cost of administration and handling of permits and to charge fees and permits those persons or entities applying for such permits; and

WHEREAS, no recommendation is necessary from the Planning Commission since it was a clerical or typographical error in the preparation of the Ordinance; and

WHEREAS, this ordinance was duly introduced and notice of this ordinance and of the public hearing having been published; and

WHEREAS, a public hearing having been held in accordance with law on the 14th day of April, 2015, at 6:00 o'clock p.m. at City Hall, Crowley, Louisiana; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF CROWLEY, ACADIA PARISH, LOUISIANA, IN REGULAR SESSION DULY CONVENED THAT:

SECTION 1: That Section 3.1304 of Article III of Appendix A – Zoning of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Crowley be and the same is hereby amended and reenacted to read as follows, to-wit:

Sec. 3.1304. Fences, walls and hedges.

Notwithstanding any other provisions of this Ordinance, fences, walls and hedges may be permitted in any required yard or along the edge of any yard provided that no fence, wall or hedge along the rear yard or side yards from the building setback line to the rear shall be over eight (8) feet in height and for front yard and side yards from the building setback line to the front yard lot line and along the front yard lot line shall not be over three (3) feet in height, unless landscape plans are filed for which permission may be granted by the Mayor and Board of Aldermen when the neighborhood will be improved by such an exception. The height of fences, walls and hedges shall be measured vertically from ground level in the adjacent yard to determine the maximum height.

Unless otherwise provided by the Code of Ordinances of the City of Crowley, a permit fee for all fences to be constructed shall be Forty & No/100 (\$40.00) Dollars plus an additional fee of Two & No/100 (\$2.00) Dollars for the cost of investigation of complaints.

SECTION 2: If any provision, part, word, section, subsection, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance should be held invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this ordinance and do hereby declare the provisions hereof to be severable, then in that event, only that particular provision, part, word, section, subsection, sentence, clause or phrase shall be deemed unconstitutional or invalid and the remaining provisions, parts, words, sections, subsections, sentences, clauses or phrases will not be affected and shall continue in full force and effect.

SECTION 3: All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent with or in conflict herewith be and the same are hereby repealed.

SECTION 4: This Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon adoption.
