CITY OF CROWLEY REGULAR COUNCIL MEETING May 9, 2006

The Mayor and Board of Aldermen of the City of Crowley, Louisiana, the governing authority of the City of Crowley, met in a regular session at 6:00 p.m. Tuesday the 9th day of May, 2006, at the regular meeting place of said Mayor and Board of Aldermen, the City Hall, 426 North Avenue F, Crowley, Louisiana.

Mayor Pro Tem Buatt presided with the following Aldermen present: Nelson Arceneaux, Tiger Istre, Woody Marceaux, Mary T. Melancon, Laurita D. Pete, Steven C. Premeaux, and Kitty Valdetero. Alderman Ira Thomas was absent.

Alderwoman Melancon led the Pledge of Allegiance to the flag and Reverend Proctor gave the invocation.

PRESENTATIONS:

Mayor Pro Tem Buatt presented certificates of appreciation to recognize and honor Mr. Hollis John Doucet, and Mr. Darryl Anthony Doucet, Jr. for their contributions that add to the pride all citizens feel about the City of Crowley. These gentlemen constructed the pavilion in Meyer Park on behalf of the Crowley Rotary Club.

Reverend Proctor appeared before the assembly, representing Dr. Ezora Proctor, to inform the assembly of the tremendous success of the "National Day of Prayer" and to invite everyone to participate in "Crowley Community Clean up Day" that will be held on May 13, 2006.

PUBLIC HEARING:

Mayor Pro Tem Buatt opened the public hearing on proposed ordinance no. 1336, the ordinance on "procedure for applying for zoning adjustments, variance, conditional uses and appeals" was read by title.

Mr. Regan asked for proponents to the proposed ordinance no. 1336. Mr. Tracy Young spoke in favor of the proposed ordinance.

The call for opponents of the proposed ordinance no. 1336 was made and there were no comments after the third and final call.

Mayor Pro Tem Buatt called the public hearing to a close.

Mayor Pro Tem Buatt opened the public hearing on proposed ordinance no. 1337, the ordinance to amend the fiscal 2006 budget was read by title.

Mr. Regan asked for opponents to the proposed ordinance no. 1337. A third and final call was made with no one coming forward to speak.

The call for proponents of the proposed ordinance no. 1337 was made and there were no comments after the third and final call.

Mayor Pro Tem Buatt called the public hearing to a close.

Mayor Pro Tem Buatt opened the public hearing on Rule to Show Cause for Condemnation of Property of Lots 4, 5, and 6 of Block 40 of Original Crowley, having a municipal address of 504 East Third Street belonging to Eleanor Finley. City Inspector, Danny Hebert said he found the buildings in compliance with building codes and did not recommend condemnation. Mr. Glenn Foreman represented the owners of the property.

Mayor Pro Tem Buatt called the public hearing to a close.

READING & APPROVAL OF MINUTES / BILLS:

Alderwoman Melancon moved to dispense with the reading of the minutes of the April 11th, 2006 regular council meeting and approve them as written and distributed. Seconded by Alderwoman Valdetero and duly adopted.

Alderwoman Melancon moved to approve all bills presented for payment. Seconded by Alderwoman Valdetero and duly adopted.

MAYOR'S REPORT:

Mayor Pro Tem Buatt presented the Sales Tax chart and User Fee chart that track the collection trend since fiscal 1992. The Recap of all Funds Report compares actual revenues and expenditures for the fiscal year 2006 to the budgeted revenues and expenditures of the same period.

STANDING COMMITTEE REPORTS:

PUBLIC WORKS:

Alderwoman Melancon offered a motion to authorize Mader Engineering to meet with Stan Keys to remedy repairs to a ramp in front of 106 East 5th Street. Seconded by Alderman Istre and duly adopted.

Alderwoman Melancon offered a motion to approve Partial Payment No. 2 to Le Talley Ho for the 2005-06 Annual Street Repair Contract in the amount of \$62,601.89, which represents 69% of completion. Seconded by Alderwoman Valdetero and duly adopted.

Alderwoman Melancon offered a motion to authorize Mader Engineering Inc. to prepare plans and specifications for the 2006-07 Annual Materials and Street Repair contracts. Seconded by Alderwoman Pete and duly adopted.

Alderwoman Melancon offered a motion to extend the curb at 106 East 5th Street under the Le Talley Ho for the 2005-06 Annual Street Repair Contract. Seconded by Alderman Marceaux and duly adopted.

Alderwoman Valdetero offered a motion accept the city attorney's recommendation not to accept the agreement that provide changes and releases for Shady Oaks. Seconded by Alderwoman Melancon and duly adopted.

UTILITY:

Alderman Marceaux offered a motion to authorize the Mayor and the City Attorney to advertise for bids for a vacuum pressure truck. Seconded by Alderwoman Melancon and duly adopted.

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND APPENDIX A, "THE ZONING ORDINANCE", ORDINANCE NO 1059 OF THE CITY OF CROWLEY; TO AMEND AND RE-ENACT SECTION 9.6 TO ADD SUBSECTION 9.604 TO PROVIDE A PROCEDURE FOR APPLYING FOR AND SEEKING ZONING ADJUSTMENTS, VARIANCE, CONDITIONAL USES AND APPEALS; TO PROVIDE FOR THE NATURE THEREOF, THE **INFORMATION** DOCUMENTATION REQUIRED, **NOTIFICATION** REQUREMENTS, FEES AND THE FORMS CERTIFICATIONS THEREFOR; TO PROVIDE THE PROVISIONS THEREOF TO BE SEVERABLE; AND TO **ORDINANCES PARTS** REPEAL ALL OR OF ORDINANCES IN CONTRARY THERETO AND/OR IN CONFLICT THEREWITH; AND TO PROVIDE FOR ALL MATTERS RELATIVE THERETO.

WHEREAS, it is necessary and desirable to provide and define procedures for appeals for variances, zoning adjustments and conditional use of property which are subject

to requirements, limitations, interpretations and decisions made under the provisions of the Zoning Ordinance be provided; and

WHEREAS, by adopting a procedure, a more organized and efficient process will result; and

WHEREAS, prospective purchasers should be allowed to represent the owner for such adjustments prior to acquiring ownership of the property; and

WHEREAS, this ordinance has been duly introduced and notice of this ordinance and notice of public hearing having been published; and

WHEREAS, a public hearing having been held in accordance with law on the 9th day of May, 2006, at 6:00 o'clock p.m. at City Hall, Crowley, Louisiana; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF CROWLEY, ACADIA PARISH, LOUISIANA, IN REGULAR SESSION DULY CONVENED THAT:

SECTION 1: Section 9.6 of Article IX of Appendix A of Ordinance No. 1059 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Crowley be and it is hereby amended and re-enacted to add thereto the following subsections, to-wit:

Sec. 9.6. Powers and duties.

(9.604) The following additional requirements, procedures and general instructions for application for zoning adjustments, including a variance, conditional use or appeals from the restrictions or limitations of the ordinance, shall be followed and all applicants shall use the application form and provide the documentation certification attached. Applicants may be the owner or the owner's designated representative provided specific written authorization is attached to the application.

(1) Nature of appeal/adjustment/variance/conditional use

In describing the exact nature and type of appeal, adjustment, variance or conditional use being requested, the applicant must clearly indicate the specific requirements that are being requested and/or the administrative decision or interpretation that is being appealed. The applicant should describe the particular provisions of this Ordinance or other laws that prevent the proposed use or construction and how the literal interpretation of the provisions of the Zoning Ordinance would deprive the applicant of rights commonly enjoyed by other properties in the same district under the terms of this Ordinance. Any person shall make application through the office of the Zoning Administration.

(2) Supporting Information

The applicant must provide a site plan as a part of the application. The site plan shall be drawn to a scale and fifteen (15) copies provided. The site plan must accurately show north arrow, vicinity map, streets, sidewalks, property lines, location of utilities, natural features, easements, the location of existing and proposed construction, open yard areas, curbs, fences, walks, driveways, parking (with each space clearly delineated), entrances and exits, signs and any other information the Zoning Administration may deem appropriate to present to the Board of Zoning Adjustment.

Upon request, fifteen (15) copies of elevations of the proposed development must be provided.

(3) Notification

In applying for a variance, the applicant shall supply the names and addresses typed on gum-backed labels of owners of property within two hundred (200') feet of the perimeter of the property where the variance is being sought.

(4) Fee

A filing fee of one hundred fifty & no/100 (\$150.00) dollars must accompany every application.

(5) Attendance

No action will be taken on any application unless the applicant or authorized agent is present at the meeting to answer any questions that may be raised at the meeting.

(6) Application form and certification and agreement

The following application form and certification agreement shall be completed, to-wit:

(Application Form and Certificate and Agreement attached)

SECTION 2: If any provision, part, word, section, subsection, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance should be held invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this ordinance and do hereby declare the provisions hereof to be severable, then in that event, only that particular provision, part, word, section, subsection, sentence, clause or phrase shall be deemed unconstitutional or invalid and the remaining provisions, parts, words, sections, subsections, sentences, clauses or phrases will not be affected and shall continue in full force and effect; and

SECTION 3: All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent with or in conflict herewith be and the same are hereby repealed;

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, the Mayor of the City of Crowley, Isabella L. de la Houssaye, is hereby authorized and in her sole discretion, to make such changes within the various budget classifications as she may deem necessary.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, if any provision, part, word, section, subsection, sentence, clause, or phrase of this ordinance should be held invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this ordinance and do hereby declare the provisions hereof, to be severable, then in that event, only that particular provision, part, word, section, subsection, sentence, clause or phrase shall be deemed unconstitutional or invalid and the remaining provisions, parts, words, sections, subsections, sentences, clauses or phrases will not be affected and shall continue in full force and effect.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that all ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent with or in conflict herewith be and the same are hereby repealed.
