The Mayor and Board of Aldermen of the City of Crowley, Louisiana, the governing authority of the City of Crowley, met in a regular session at 6:00 p.m. Tuesday the 13<sup>th</sup> day of August 2019 at the regular meeting place of said Mayor and Board of Aldermen, the Council Chambers, 426 North Avenue F, Crowley, Louisiana.

A motion was made by Alderman Sammy Reggie and seconded by Alderman Vernon Martin to authorize the City Attorney to prepare a resolution to amend the Crowley Code of Ordinances under Chapter 2, Sec. 2-3(a), to change the date for regular monthly city council meetings from the 2<sup>nd</sup> Tuesday of the month to the 2<sup>nd</sup> Wednesday of the month. Motion carried.

A motion was offered by Alderman Jeff Cavell and seconded by Alderman Vernon Martin to offer the resolution of the Mayor and Board of Aldermen of the City of Crowley, Acadia Parish, Louisiana, authorizing a lease to the assist agency for office space in the Crowley Enterprise Center located at 11 North Parkerson Avenue, Crowley, Louisiana; to provide for the terms and conditions thereof; and to provide for all matters relative thereto. Alderman Jeff Cavell rescinded his motion.

Alderman Lyle Fogleman made a motion to table the resolution to be heard at the next council meeting. Seconded by Alderman Brad Core. Motion carried with Alderman Byron Wilridge recusing himself due to a family member serving on the board.

A motion was offered by Alderman Jeff Cavell and seconded by Alderwoman Kim Stringfellow that the Committee recommend to the full Council that the Administration prepare a resolution to resolve the lawsuit filed by the Civil Service Board against the City of Crowley, which includes all members of the Council, individually, and to resolve this matter as soon as possible by the following:

- 1) Allowing the Civil Service Board to increase its secretary's salary up to the maximum amount allowed by law;
- 2) Provide office space, furnishings, equipment and supplies necessary for its operations, as provided by law; and
- 3) Provide payment in full for bills submitted by Attorney Aaron Green relative to his representation of the Civil Service Board concerning this litigation matter.

Mr. Jeff Cavell yielded the motion to Alderman Lyle Fogleman. Alderman Lyle Fogleman offered and seconded by Alderman Steven Premeaux to amend the motion to authorize City Attorney to meet with the Attorney Aaron Green to try to resolve this matter based on the information. Motion carried.

**OTHER BUSINESS:**

Mayor Tim Monceaux asked the council members to please keep City Attorney Tom Regan in prayers as he undergoes a medical procedure.

There being no further business to come before the Council upon motion duly made by Alderman Lyle Fogleman and seconded by Alderman Brad Core the meeting was adjourned at 7:39 p.m.
