## Occupational License Requirements

To Whom It May Concern:

If you are applying for an occupational license, these are the step you need to follow in order to obtain a license.

- 1. Give your location to the City Inspector so that he can verify to the City Clerk that you are in a proper commercial zone.
- 2. Register for sales tax at the Acadia Parish School Board Office on North Parkerson.
- 3. Apply for beer or liquor license through the City Clerk's office if these items are to be sold.
- 4. Obtain a Health Certificate from the Acadia Parish Health Unit on West Mill Street, if food, beverages and etc. are to be sold.
- 5. Apply for Occupational License at Crowley City Hall, 425 N. Parkerson, Crowley. The hours are from 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m.
- 6. If you are starting a taxi service you must first bring a bond providing that you are insured.
- 7. Certain occupational licenses require bonds or insurance coverage. Inquire with us before obtaining a license with the City. Ex: Photographer, Taxi Service, Housemoving, etc.
