A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF CROWLEY, ACADIA PARISH, LOUISIANA, AUTHORIZING AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT (CEA) WITH THE ACADIA PARISH POLICE JURY FOR THE OVERLAY OF A 600 LINEAR FOOT PORTION OF HOYT AVENUE UNDER THE CITY OF CROWLEY'S 2021 CITY-WIDE STREET IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT; AND TO PROVIDE FOR ALL MATTERS RELATIVE THERETO.

WHEREAS, the City of Crowley awarded the contracts for the 2021 City-Wide Street Improvements Project to Glenn Lege Construction Inc. for the improvement of streets within the City of Crowley; and

WHEREAS, the Acadia Parish Police Jury has requested a portion of Hoyt Avenue located outside of the City of Crowley's corporate limits measuring approximately 600 linear feet to be included in the City's 2021 City-Wide Street Improvements Project contingent upon the Acadia Parish Police Jury being responsible for the cost thereof (estimated to be \$20,000.00 to \$30,000.00); and

WHEREAS, the Police Jury has agreed to maintain that portion of Hoyt Avenue after completion of the City's Project; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Board of Aldermen deem it appropriate to include that said portion of Hoyt Avenue located outside of the City's corporate limits in the 2021 City-Wide Street Improvements Project and that an Intergovernmental Agreement (CEA) providing for all other matters relative thereto is necessary and appropriate therefor;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Aldermen of the City of Crowley, Acadia Parish, Louisiana, in regular session duly convened that they do hereby authorize, empower and direct the Honorable Chad Monceaux, Mayor of the City of Crowley, to execute an Intergovernmental Agreement (CEA) with the Acadia Parish Police Jury to overlay a portion of Hoyt Avenue located outside of the City's corporate limits measuring approximately 600 linear feet which overlay work shall be included in the City of Crowley's 2021 City-Wide Street Improvements Project which Intergovernmental Agreement (CEA) shall include all the terms and conditions as may be necessary and proper in connection therewith, including the responsibility of the Acadia Parish Police Jury to bear all costs in connection with the overlay project and shall reimburse the City for payments made for work as approved by the City Engineer and shall require the Acadia Parish Police Jury to maintain that portion of Hoyt Avenue after completion of the Project.
