REGULAR MEETING  
FEBRUARY 18, 2026

The Mayor and Board of Aldermen of the City of Crowley, Louisiana, the governing authority of the City of Crowley, met in a regular session at 5:00 p.m. Wednesday, the 18<sup>TH</sup> day of February 2026 at the regular meeting place of said Mayor and Board of Aldermen, the Council Chambers, 426 North Avenue F, Crowley, Louisiana.

Mayor Chad Monceaux presided with the following Aldermen present: Katie Chiasson, Dickie Latiolais, Thompson Bradford Core, Jeff Doré, Vernon Martin, Dickie Latiolias, and Chuck Ashby and Sandra Marx.

Alderman Samuel J. Reggie III and Alderman Byron K. Wilridge were absent.

Alderman Chuck Ashby gave the invocation. Alderman Brad Core led the Pledge of Allegiance to the flag.

**READING & APPROVAL OF MINUTES:**

Alderman Vernon Martin moved to dispense with the reading of the January 20, 2026, Regular Council meeting seconded by Alderwoman Sandra Marx and duly adopted.

**RECREATION COMMITTEE:**

A motion was made by Alderman Chuck Ashby and seconded by Alderman Vernon Martin to adoption a resolution authorizing a grant application under the Louisiana Government Assistance Program (LGAP) for improvements to the Historic Miller Stadium Grandstands. **WHEREAS**, applications for the Louisiana Office of Community Development's FY 2025-

**WHEREAS**, the City of Crowley wishes to submit an application for funding Historic Miller Stadium Grandstands Improvements under the Office of Community Development FY 2025 - 2026 LGAP grant program.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the City of Crowley that the Mayor be, and he is hereby empowered, authorized and directed to prepare and submit for and on behalf of the City of Crowley a Fiscal Year 2025 - 2026 grant application to the Office of Community Development under its Local Government Assistance Program for Historic Miller Stadium Grandstands Improvements, and to execute same on behalf of the City of Crowley and by his signature to enter into any and all contractual obligations on behalf of the City of Crowley under this program.

**THEREUPON**, the above resolution was duly adopted.

**ZONING & ANNEXATION COMMITTEE:**

A motion was made by Alderman Vernon Martin and seconded by Alderwoman Sandra Marx to approve Partial Payment #3 to CO-D Construction of La., LLC. for the "Drainage Improvements for Lawrence Acres & VFW Drive" project in the amount of \$224,341.43. The motion having been submitted to a voice vote; Alderman Bryon Wilridge and Sammy Reggie were absent; the motion was carried.

**PUBLIC BUILDINGS COMMITTEE:**

A motion was made by Alderman Jeff Dore and seconded by Alderwoman Sandra Marx to approve the application for Payment No. 15 to Prestige Construction Group, LLC for the Urban Park and Pavilion Project, in the amount of \$173,479.26. Mayor Monceaux opened the floor for discussion. There being no remarks from the Council. The motion having been submitted to a voice vote; Alderman Bryon Wilridge and Samuel Reggie were absent; Alderman Vernon Martin opposed; the motion was carried.

**COMMUNITY & ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT COMMITTEE:**

A motion was made by Alderwoman Katie Chiasson and seconded by Alderwoman Sandra Marx to approve the request of Ms. Natalie Russel to close Parkerson Ave. on July 11, 2026, and waive the open container restriction for alcoholic beverages for the day to allow for a Bike Show to raise funds for the Down Syndrome Association. Mayor Monceaux opened the floor for discussion. There being no remarks from the Council. The motion having been submitted to a voice vote; Alderman Sammy Reggie and Byron Wilridge were absent; the motion was carried.
