The Mayor and Board of Aldermen of the City of Crowley, Louisiana, the governing authority of the City of Crowley, met in a regular session at 5:00 p.m. Tuesday, the 21ST day of April 2026 at the regular meeting place of said Mayor and Board of Aldermen, the Council Chambers, 426 North Avenue F, Crowley, Louisiana.

Mayor Chad Monceaux presided with the following Aldermen present: Katie Chiasson, Dickie Latiolais, Thompson Bradford Core, Jeff Doré, Dickie Latiolias, and Chuck Ashby, Sandra Marx and Alderman Samuel J. Reggie III.

Alderman Bryon K. Wilridge and Alderman Vernon Martin was absent.

Alderman Chuck Ashby gave the invocation. Police Chief Troy Hebert led the Pledge of Allegiance to the flag.

NOTICE is hereby given in compliance with La. R.S. 42:19.1, that the City Council of the City of Crowley, Louisiana, will meet in open and public session on the 19th day of May, 2026, at 5:00 p.m., at the regular meeting place of said Mayor and Board of Aldermen, the Council Chambers, 426 North Avenue F, Crowley, Louisiana, to consider calling an election to be held in the City of Crowley, Louisiana, on November 3, 2026, for renewal of ½ of 1% sales and use tax for acquiring, constructing, maintaining and improving infrastructure and capital improvements within the city, with the proceeds of the tax to be subject to funding into bonds, and three (3) ad valorem taxes for (i) maintaining the wastewater disposal facilities, (ii) of public parks and recreation, and (iii) of youth recreation building maintenance.

A motion was made by Alderman Samuel Reggie and seconded by Alderwoman Sandra Marx to approve the Preliminary and Final Plat Showing the Subdivision of Property Owned by LIMCO, INC. and PBN PROPERTIES, LLC and GBL LEGACY, LLC into Tract A, contingent upon the technical review and approval by the Designated Review Agent, Mader Engineering, Inc. Mayor Monceaux opened the floor for discussion. There being no remarks from the Council. The motion having been submitted to a voice vote; Alderman Byron Wilridge was absent; the motion was carried.


