The Mayor and Board of Aldermen of the City of Crowley, Louisiana, the governing authority of the City of Crowley, met in a special session at 3:00 p.m. Wednesday the 1st day of July 2026 at the regular meeting place of said Mayor and Board of Aldermen, the Council Chambers, 426 North Avenue F, Crowley, Louisiana.

Mayor Chad Monceaux presided with the following Aldermen present: Thompson Bradford Core, Jeff Doré, Dickie Latiolais, Vernon Martin, Sandy Marx.

Alderman Samuel J. Reggie III, Chuck Ashby, Katie Chiasson, Bryon K Wilridge, Sr. were absent.

Alderman Vernon Martin gave the invocation. Alderman Dickie Latiolais led the Pledge of Allegiance to the flag.

A motion was made by Alderwoman Sandra Marx and seconded by Alderman Brad Core to approve suspending the Open Container Law for the Urban Park & Pavillion at 11 N Parkerson and a two (2) block radius surrounding the facility and the Tony Robicheaux Sports complex at 717 W Mill St for the July 4th Celebration. Mayor Monceaux opened the floor for discussion. A motion to amend the original motion was made by Alderman Brad Core and seconded by Alderman Vernon Martin to approve suspending the Open Container Law for the Urban Park & Pavillion at 11 N Parkerson and the Tony Robicheaux Sports complex at 717 W Mill St for the July 4th Celebration, removing the two (2) radius surrounding the Urban Park & Pavillion from the motion. Mayor Monceaux opened the floor for discussion. There being no remarks from the Council. The motion having been submitted to a voice vote; the motion was carried unanimously.

There being no further business to come before the Council upon motion duly made by Alderman Brad Core and seconded by Alderman Jeff Dore the meeting was adjourned at 3:06 p.m.
