REGULAR MEETING
JULY 21, 2026

The Mayor and Board of Aldermen of the City of Crowley, Louisiana, the governing authority of the City of Crowley, met in a regular session at 5:00 p.m. Tuesday, the 21st day of July 2026 at the regular meeting place of said Mayor and Board of Aldermen, the Council Chambers, 426 North Avenue F, Crowley, Louisiana.

Mayor Chad Monceaux presided with the following Aldermen present: Katie Chiasson, Dickie Latiolais, Thompson Bradford Core, Jeff Doré, Dickie Latiolias, Chuck Ashby, Sandra Marx, Vernon Martin, Bryon K. Wilridge and Samuel J. Reggie III.

None were absent.

Alderman Chuck Ashby gave the invocation. Alderwoman Katie Chiasson led the Pledge of Allegiance to the flag.

READING & APPROVAL OF MINUTES:

Alderman Vernon Martin moved to dispense with the reading of the June 16, 2026, Regular Council meeting seconded by Alderman Byron Wilridge and duly adopted.

Alderman Brad Core moved to dispense with the reading of the July 1, 2026, Special Council meeting seconded by Alderwoman Sandra Marx and duly adopted.

MAYOR'S REPORTS:

Mayor Chad Monceaux presented the Sales Tax chart and User Fee chart that track the collection trend.

Mayor Chad Monceaux presented the monthly budget-to-actual comparisons through June 30, 2026.

COMMITTEE REPORTS:

PUBLIC WORKS COMMITTEE:

A motion was made by Alderman Vernon Martin seconded by Alderman Byron Wilridge to consider the dedication of that portion Fourth Street from Moore Avenue Westward to its terminus in Memory of Edna Harmon Robinson and erection of signage commemorating said dedication. Mayor Monceaux opened the floor for the discussion. Ms. Alicia Coles spoke on behalf of the family and requested that the dedication be for Fifth Street and in the name of her mother and father. A substitute motion was offer by Alderman Bryon Wilridge and seconded by Alderman Vernon Martin to consider the dedication of that portion Fifth Street from Moore Avenue Westward to its terminus in Memory of Mr. & Mrs. Rogers Robinson and erection of signage commemorating said dedication. Mayor Monceaux opened the floor for the discussion. There being no further discussion from the Council.

ZONING & ANNEXATION COMMITTEE:

A motion was made by Alderman Sammy Reggie and seconded by Alderman Brad Core approve re-zoning "Land Swap" In the exchange, Pauer Properties is swapping a parcel of land zoned C-4 for a parcel of land zoned C-3. With this exchange, they are requesting that the newly acquired piece of land be re-zoned C-4 to match the existing/remainder of their tract which is also zoned C-4. Mayor Monceaux opened the floor for discussion. There being no remarks from the Council. The motion having been submitted to a voice vote; the motion was carried.

A motion was made by Alderman Sammy Reggie and seconded by Alderwoman Sandra Marx approve the Preliminary & Final Plat of Dixie Field Property, LLC the addition of Lot 5 to Grandview Development Phase I (A Commercial Development). 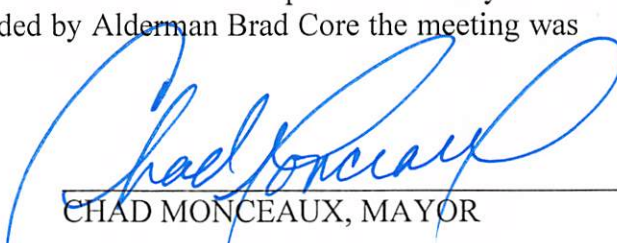
