Through the 2025-26 Trash Receptacle Grant Program, Keep Louisiana Beautiful awarded 230 receptacles to 47 organizations in 31 parishes.

As part of the requirements of this grant, City of Crowley will perform a post installation litter scan and compare the data collected to preliminary scan results. Data will be shared with the public once available.
